Preview the Tutorials

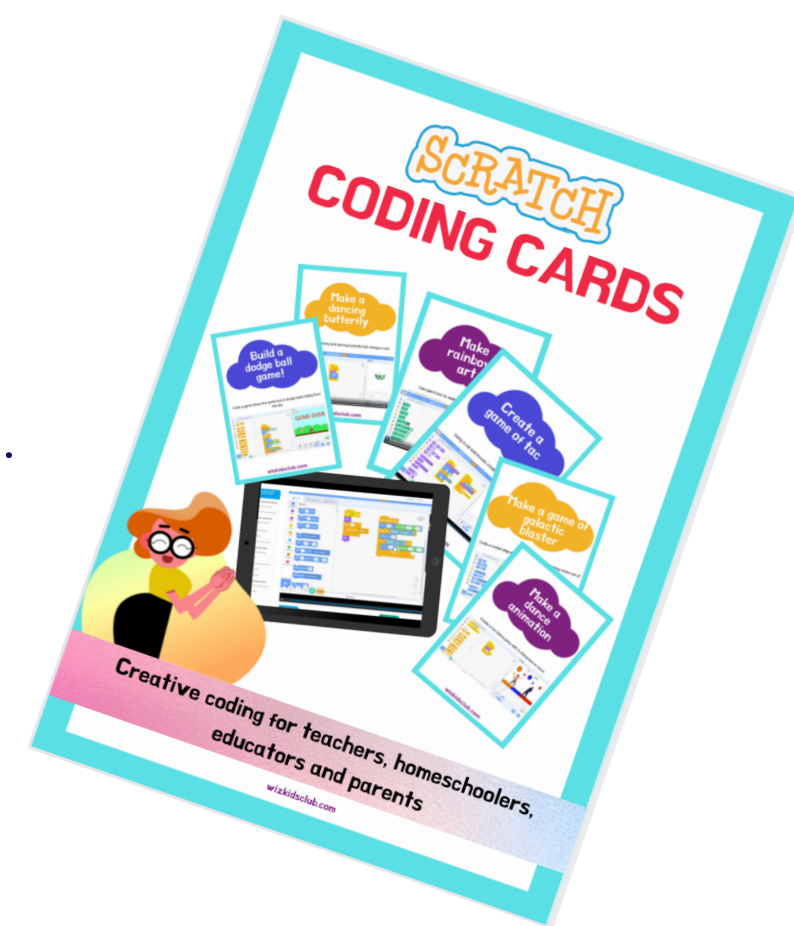
- Getting familiar with the step-by-step tutorials are a great way to get started.

Set up your Scratch account

Kids can sign up for their own Scratch accounts at scratch.mit.edu, or you can set up student accounts if you have a Teacher Account. To request a Teacher Account, go to: scratch.mit.edu/educators
